

CSSE Support for Short-term Scholarly Events

The mission of CSSE is to advance knowledge and inform practice in educational settings. Our major scholarly event is the yearly conference at Congress. However, CSSE is also anxious to encourage meetings throughout the year and provides seed money (Maximum \$2500 per event) for short term scholarly events that support its mission. Funded organizers of such events must ensure that the CSSE logo appear on all conference materials and advertising, and that the Society be acknowledged at the event.

We invite proposals for seed money support of short-term scholarly events. These events may be one- or two-day conferences, institutes, symposia or workshops. The proposals will be judged according to the following criteria:

- The event aligns with the CSSE mission and objectives.
- Priority will be given to events that reflect interdisciplinarity (essentially bridging the interests of various associations within CSSE).
- The event is held between 1 October and 31 March so as not to overlap with the annual conference.
- Provision is made for graduate student participation at cost.
- The applicant must be a current member of CSSE.

Title, date, location

Objectives

Rationale, with an explanation of how the objectives fit with the CSSE objectives and how the Society will be acknowledged and publicized during the event.

Organizers and intended participants

Draft program

Plans for dissemination of outcomes

Budget
