Exceptionality Education International (EEI) provides a forum for scholarly exchange among international professionals in education and related disciplines such as nursing, rehabilitation medicine, physical education, law, and speech and language. The purpose of the peer-reviewed journal is to present current research and theory from a wide range of disciplines and to identify emerging trends and visions for individuals with exceptionalities.

Examples of relevant topics include, but are not limited to: giftedness, learning disorders, behavioural disorders, inclusion, deafness studies, social and emotional development, and minority populations. We welcome scholarship that advances our understanding and knowledge of students across the spectrum of exceptionality and from associated disciplines.

Articles considered for publication include:

- * Original research with practical relevance to individuals with exceptional needs;
- * Critical reviews of substantive area(s);
- * Theoretical position papers;
- * Descriptions, reviews, or evaluations of innovative instruction, curricula, programs, or models of education for students with exceptionalities;
- * Historical and philosophical perspectives.
